### 2011 Tax Legislation for the CA Practitioner

This session will contrast and compare various aspects of Federal and California tax law, as it highlights the most important changes for 2011. The comprehensive coverage of Federal and California legislation includes conformity and nonconformity issues.

#### A Forms Based Approach

Claudia Hill is a nationally recognized tax professional and frequent lecturer on taxation of individuals and representation before the IRS. She is Editor in Chief of the CCH, Inc. "Journal of Tax Practice & Procedure." Ms. Hill has testified before both the Senate Finance Committee and House Ways & Means Committee on tax issues, including tax law complexity and the Alternative Minimum Tax.

In March 2005, Claudia was invited to testify about the individual AMT at the President's Tax Reform Panel. She is often called upon by the media for comment about tax issues. She served on the 1987 Commissioner's Advisory Group to the National Office of the Internal Revenue Service.

She is a member of the National Association of Enrolled Agents, an associate member of the ABA Tax Section, and a life member of the American Tax Policy Institute
