### CSEA September Board Meeting Summary

The Board of Directors of the California Society of Enrolled Agents met at a regularly scheduled meeting on September 10 -11, 2005, at the Lion's Gate Hotel, Sacramento, California.

The Board approved a dues increase of five dollars in all categories for the 2006-2007 fiscal year.

The board approved funding for the Bob Brinker Show for the 2005-2006 fiscal year.

The board adopted ProfNet as an ongoing Member benefit.

A policy statement was approved regarding the Major Media Marketing Fund.

CSEA will enter into a letter of intent with the IRS to assist the evacuees from Hurricane Katrina through our disaster services program. The letter will be signed by the CSEA president after the approval of the Executive Committee.

On Sunday, September 11, 2005, an accident occurred involving a courier transporting mostly 1040ES payments to an IRS Lockbox. Following are details regarding the accident:

Where: San Mateo Bridge, San Francisco Bay Area, CA

Approximately 30,000 pieces of mail went into the San Francisco Bay

Effected States - Alaska, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Virginia, Washington, and Wyoming

If contact is received regarding the accident, advise the taxpayer that the IRS is aware of the problem and is in the process of identifying impacted taxpayers so that the IRS can take appropriate action. Procedures will be provided by the end of September.
